- Make and execute a plan for outreach to Black communities and help us gather feedback and understand the needs of these communities
- Make recommendations for improvements or changes to our physical space as necessary, and support implementation of changes
- Make recommendations for how to appropriately mark or celebrate relevant holidays or cultural observation days
- Make recommendations for training that our personnel should participate in as appropriate
- Develop an evaluation and feedback framework that SPECTRUM can use ongoingly to ensure our accessibility and relevance to Black communities, and support implementation

- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Strategic thinking
- Experience in equity and inclusion work
